Please keep in mind that the vehicles being offered here today are offered without guarantee as to the condition of any item. **Vehicles are warranted as to description only. Condition is not guaranteed. I repeat, vehicles are warranted as to description only, condition is not guaranteed.** Deficiencies, when known, will be announced. However, absence of announced deficiencies does not necessarily mean there are none. We strongly encourage you to inspect the vehicles before you bid.

These vehicles have been purchased with your federal tax dollar and to protect that investment, upset prices have been established. This means that if the bidding does not reach that minimum, no award will be made and all bids for that item will be considered rejected. Rejected vehicles, if any, may be reoffered during this sale.

GSA employees or members of the employee's immediate household, as well as the auction house, any sub-contractor, their employees, or members of their immediate households are ineligible to purchase vehicles at this sale.

All bidders must be at least 18 years old. You must be registered to bid and have a bidder number. If you have not registered, please do so now. Your name and address will appear on your certificate to obtain title exactly as you have registered. No changes will be made at a later time. You will be required to sign your sale documents and provide your Social Security number or tax ID number if it has not already been provided.

With the growing concerns around the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) we want to update our customers on the status of our sales. For the time being all of our auctions are proceeding as scheduled. However, many auctions have switched to internet bidding only with no physical attendance allowed in the lanes. Please review the promotion field under the sale details on our sale calendar for further information for each sale or contact the auction house. We encourage all buyers to buy online to the maximum extent possible to minimize possible exposure. To bid online, please contact the auction house as soon as possible to register for internet bidding. Don't wait until the day of the sale.

Successful bidders will be issued a bill of sale, and a Standard Form 97 which is a federal certificate to obtain title to a vehicle. It includes odometer disclosure statements. The Standard Form 97 is not a registration form but the certificate to be presented to register your vehicle.

Acceptable forms of payment include: cashiers checks, money orders, and personal checks (when accompanied by a bank letter of guarantee acceptable to the auction house), cash and the following credit cards - Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover. Checks are to be made payable to the (auction facility). Effective June 1, 2015, the maximum dollar amount allowed on one credit card will be \$24,999.00.

Property purchased must be paid for in full and removed by 4PM TODAY.
