Public Registration Contract Agreement

I hereby request that Alaska Equipment & Fleet Auctions issue an auction participation number, with which the auction permits me to consign, preview, and purchase at public auction. In consideration thereof, I: 1) agree to notify auction immediately of the loss or theft of bidding number. 2) agree to comply with all the rules and procedures of auction. 3) acknowledge and agree that as to any vehicle or item brought upon auction premises by or for me, whether for sale at the auction or otherwise, or purchased at the auction and left there for any reason whatsoever, that such vehicle or item is left on the premises at my sole risk and I expressly release auction from any liability for loss resulting from fire, theft, vandalism or any other causes not due to the auction's sole negligence. 4) by signing, I indicate that I have read and understand all portions of this agreement, **including the reverse side of this form**, and have read the terms, conditions, and payment policy, and agree to abide by all of the rules and policies of the auction. I also agree to abide by all policies and rules that may be posted on the auction's premises, web-site, and any other correspondence that may be sent to me either in writing or electronically.

For the receipt of a bidding number, buyer agrees that if the highest bid is accepted, a contract is formed between the seller and buyer. The contract is enforceable when the auctioneer accepts the buyer's bid and declares item to be sold. Auction reserves the right to refuse issuing a bidder number. Alaska Equipment & Fleet Auctions does not make guarantees or warranties, expressed or implied, of any kind, related to any vehicle or item. All vehicles and items are sold at public auction "AS-IS, WHERE-IS", WITH NO WARRANTY, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR MERCHANTABILITY. Consignor is responsible for providing an accurate vehicle or item description, including year, model, mileage, and title defects. Buyer is solely responsible to verify Consignor's representations before removing vehicle/items on the day of sale. Buyer further agrees to hold Dealers Auto Auction of Alaska harmless with regards to the purchase and operation of any vehicle or item purchased. The auction may, at its discretion, offer appropriate recourse to buyer, including cancelling or (unwinding) of the sale, if auction believes the vehicle or item was materially misrepresented by seller.

If a consigned vehicle sells, a seller's fee will be charged and deducted from proceeds, along with any other fees for requested services. If you purchase a vehicle/item, a buyer's premium will be charged, along with any other fees for requested services. Vehicle/Item Registration and No-Sale fees may also be charged to the consignor. A vehicle release and title for any consigned vehicle may be obtained at the front counter. All fees owed must be paid prior to obtaining a vehicle release or title. To register, all persons must be 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license. No one less than 18 years of age allowed on auction premises.

Buying at AEF Public Auctions

- INITIAL < I understand that at each auction I agree to pay a buyer's premium applicable to the auction for which I am registering. I understand the buyer premiums are subject to change per auction.
- INITIAL < I understand that if I purchase a titled vehicle, the title will be issued in my name or company name, **exactly as I have registered**, and will not be put into a third party name by the auction.
- INITIAL < The purchaser will be afforded the opportunity to view all lots prior to sale. The purchaser must understand that he/she is buying property entirely upon his/her own or his/her agent's examination and opinion. All lots are sold "**AS IS, WHERE IS**" with all faults and defects. Any guarantees written or implied as to the authenticity, originality, or condition of any lot are not the guarantee of the Auction Company, and should be determined by the purchaser's own inspection and discretion.
- INITIAL < The property and information presented at the **time of auction** is final and supersedes any previous representations. Items in the auction may not meet their minimum "Reserve" price and may not sell to the highest bidder. Items may also be removed or "pulled" from auction bidding at any time.
- INITIAL < In the cases of disputed bids, the lot shall be resold, but the auctioneer will use his best judgment as to the good faith of all claims and his decision is final. Items in the auction may not meet their "Reserve" price and may not sell to the highest bidder.
- INITIAL < **The item description information provided is deemed reliable, but is not guaranteed.** Vehicle history report services are provided by many companies and are available via the internet. Bidders are responsible for deciding whether or not to purchase a vehicle history report. The content of vehicle history reports **will not be grounds** for cancelling a sale, unless the history content denotes salvage, reconstruct, or flood damage that was not declared. Sales will not be cancelled if either the aforementioned history content, or title problems have been found to be the result of clerical errors. The auction will be given a reasonable amount of time to correct these errors.
- INITIAL < If bidding via the internet, I understand that technical problems may arise that are beyond the auction's control. This may cause my bid or bids to be late, or not received by the auction. I hold the auction harmless from any technical issues causing my bids to be late or not acknowledged. The auctioneer may void any internet bids at his discretion. If bidding via the internet(Simulcast), it is highly recommended that you bid early in order to let the auctioneer know that he has an interested remote bidder. **Due to internet delays, trying to "snipe" a winning bid at the last second will normally result in losing the bid to a floor bidder. Internet bids that arrive after the auctioneer has announced "sold" to another bidder, will be retracted by the auction clerk.**
